Library Update Effective June 3, 2020

Per Governor Baker's announcement regarding the Reopening Phases, the Stevens Memorial Library building will remain closed to the public until the Library implements Phase 2 (TBD). All Library programs and meetings have been canceled until further notice.

Curbside Service: Curbside Service will be available starting June 3. To request items, you may call or email the Library. You may also request items online, but be sure to request "Ashburnham" copies only at this time, as interlibrary loan delivery is not currently available (Delivery restart date, TBD). When your requested items are available, you will receive a phone call to choose a date and time slot for pick up. Please remember to pick up your items on time, so that we can maintain social distancing and keep the process manageable and safe.

Hours for curbside pickup are as follows:

- Monday, Tuesday, Thursday: 10-4
- Wednesday: 10-8
- Saturday: 10-2

Book Drop & Returns: We are accepting returns via the Book drop only at this time. All returned items will be placed in quarantine for 72 hours before being checked in. The book drop is for returning Library materials. Book donations can be deposited in the Book Donations Bin located in the Library parking lot.
